RULES

- 1 RESOLUTION urging the Ohio Secretary of State and the Ohio General Assembly to create a process by which independent/non-partisan voters may vote in a political party’s primary without declaring for that party; and declaring an emergency.
- 2 ORDINANCE amending and supplementing Title 3 “Administration”, Chapter 30 “Mayor and Council,” Section 30.11 “Limits on monetary and in-kind contributions and loans” of the Akron Codified Ordinances; and declaring an emergency.

BUDGET & FINANCE

- 3 ORDINANCE approving the agreements between the Fraternal Order of Police Akron Lodge #7, Local #1360/Ohio Council 8 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, and the Civil Service Personnel Association, Inc. bargaining units, and the City of Akron regarding adjustments in employee compensation; providing for these adjustments in compensation to apply to all employees in the non-bargaining, management, and unclassified job classes as well; all in furtherance of the Mayor’s commitment to attract and retain qualified employees and provide appropriate wage increases commensurate with improved employee productivity and efficiency, and changes in the cost of living, while economically utilizing taxpayer dollars to provide vital, quality services to the citizens of the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. ***(Substitute Offered As An Amendment.) See #1 on Regular Agenda.***
- 4 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter to a

grant agreement or agreements with United Disability Services; and declaring an emergency.

PLANNING

- 5 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to expand Greenlawn Memorial Park Cemetery at 2696 Romig Road; and declaring an emergency. *(Public Hearing Scheduled for July 29, 2019)*
- 6 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to place an additional monument sign at 985 Gorge Boulevard; and declaring an emergency. *(Public Hearing Scheduled for July 29, 2019)*
- 7 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to vary the required side yard area to construct a detached garage at 832 Chester Avenue; and declaring an emergency. *(Public Hearing Scheduled for July 29, 2019)*
- 8 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a storage building at 560 E. Tallmadge Avenue; and declaring an emergency. *(Public Hearing Scheduled for July 29, 2019)*

PUBLIC SERVICE

- 9 ORDINANCE appropriating funds for the resurfacing of certain state routes and minor bridge work to be completed by the Ohio Department of Transportation; authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement or agreements with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the resurfacing of certain streets and for certain bridge improvements; requesting the Ohio Director of Transportation to proceed with the project; and declaring an emergency.
- 10 ORDINANCE determining to proceed with and levying special assessments for the improvement and maintenance of the off-street parking facilities in the Kenmore Business District and the Canton Road Business District; and declaring an emergency.
- 11 ORDINANCE Authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into an agreement or agreements with Triban Investment, LLC to construct roadway, water, and sewer improvements for the Crossings at Auld Farm development; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- 12 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to apply for and, if awarded, accept and expend a grant administered by Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP), part of the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs; and declaring an emergency

- 13 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to apply for and, if awarded, accept and expend funding from the FY19 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) administered through the Office of Criminal Justice Services (OCJS) of the Ohio Department of Public Safety; and declaring an emergency.
- 14 RESOLUTION opposing and objecting to the renewal application of Northside Tavern, LLC, 956 N Howard Street, Akron, Ohio 44310 for a Class D2, D2X, D3 and D6 liquor permits (6451230) now pending before the Division of Liquor Control; and declaring an emergency.

- 15 RESOLUTION A resolution approving amendments to the Articles of Incorporation of the Akron-Summit County Energy Special Improvement District, Inc.; and declaring an emergency.
- 16 ORDINANCE approving the Akron-Summit County Energy Special Improvement District Residential Program Plan; authorizing and approving the execution, delivery, and performance of a City Residential PACE Cooperative Agreement with respect to property assessed clean energy transactions in cooperation with the Akron-Summit County Energy Special Improvement District and the Toledo-Lucas County Port Authority; authorizing the Toledo-Lucas County Port Authority to approve petitions and plans for public improvements or public services submitted by the owners of real property within the City requesting that their property be added to the territory of the Akron-Summit County Energy Special Improvement District and assessed for the costs of such plans on behalf of the Council of the City; and declaring an emergency.
- 17 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Submittable for access to the Submittable.com platform; and declaring an emergency.
