PLANNING

- 1 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a three-unit apartment house at 418 Crestwood Avenue; and declaring an emergency. *(Public Hearing scheduled for September 16, 2019)*
- 2 ORDINANCE amending/supplementing Title 15, Chapter 153, “Zoning Code”, Section 153.140 “Definitions” by adding discount and grocery stores, Section 153.280 “Retail Business districts” by adding discount store as an A3 or higher Area Classification; and declaring an emergency. *(Public Hearing scheduled for September 16, 2019)*

PUBLIC UTILITIES
