### AKRON CITY COUNCIL ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 16, 2019

- 1 ORD 259-2019 accepting a vacation plat for a portion of Young Street and additional land to be dedicated as Evans Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 2 ORD 260-2019 authorizing the Mayor to file an application with assurances and certifications with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Continuum of Care Application for Stewart B. McKinney funds for the homeless; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 3 ORD 261-2019 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, or her designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into contract or contracts for the repair of the garage-door openings and overhang of Fire Station 6; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 4 ORD 262-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of signal support poles for various locations throughout the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 5 ORD 263-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Novatny Electric, Co., for the emergency repair of electrical service at the Opportunity Parking Deck GOJO Bridge; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 6 ORD 264-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase of sodium hypochlorite for disinfection at the Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 7 ORD 265-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase of sodium bisulfite for disinfection at the Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)

- 8        ORD 266-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the sale of sewer-inspection cameras and related equipment to RedZone Robotics, Inc., in exchange for sewer-inspection services; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
  
- 9        ORD 267-2019 approving the addition of the property located at 1600 Raleigh Boulevard and 3395 Trumbull Avenue in Copley Township to the Copley-Akron Joint Economic Development District; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to amend the Copley-Akron JEDD agreement to include the property located at 1600 Raleigh Boulevard and 3395 Trumbull Avenue; and declaring an emergency. (Arrowhead Elem. & bus garage). VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
  
- 10       ORD 268-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish an apartment development at 44 S. Summit Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Sims abstained) (Freeman absent)
  
- 11       ORD 269-2019 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into contracts with non-profit neighborhood-based organizations for the provision of services in three categories, including diversity, equity and social inclusion; drugs and addiction; and education and youth, and authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
