BUDGET & FINANCE

- 1 ORDINANCE accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission of Summit County and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the Summit County Fiscal Officer; and declaring an emergency.
- 2 Resolution requesting that the Summit County Fiscal Officer make an advanced payment of tax funds for tax year 2019 payable in 2020 to the City of Akron Treasury Division; and declaring an emergency
- 3 ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 93-2019, passed March 25, 2019, which established the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2019; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE

- 4 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into an oil and/or gas lease agreement with Discovery Oil and Gas, LLC for the mineral rights of 2.90 acres of City-owned land for completion of the “Kopsky Unit No. 1D” gas/oil well drilling unitization; and declaring an emergency.

- 5 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into an oil and/or gas lease agreement with Discovery Oil and Gas, LLC for the mineral rights of 2.87 acres of City-owned land for completion of the “Kintz Unit No. 1” gas/oil well drilling unitization; and declaring an emergency.
- 6 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into an oil and/or gas lease agreement with Discovery Oil and Gas, LLC for the mineral rights of 4.26 acres of City-owned land for completion of the “Eubanks Unit No. 1D” gas/oil well drilling unitization; and declaring an emergency.
- 7 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement/participatory legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for certain improvements of the Princeton Street Bridge over State Route 76; declaring that said project is in the public interest; and declaring an emergency.
- 7A RESOLUTION declaring it necessary to improve East Market Street between the termini of Canton Road and Interstate 76, Seiberling Street between the termini of Triplett Boulevard and Archwood Avenue, Innovation Way between the termini of East Market Street and Seiberling Street, Vernon Odom Boulevard between the termini of Romig Road and McTaggart Drive and Opportunity Parkway between the termini of Edgewood Avenue and Cedar Street by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- 8 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to accept an Assistance to Firefighters Grant from the Department of Homeland Security for the purchase of certain equipment for the Akron Fire Division; authorizing the expenditure of local matching funds from the appropriate account or accounts; authorizing the purchase of said equipment after publicly advertising for bids; and declaring an emergency.
