AKRON CITY COUNCIL ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 30, 2019

- 1 ORD 273-2019 accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission of Summit County and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the Summit County Fiscal Officer; and declaring an emergency. Vote 12-0 (Neal absent)

- 2 RES 274-2019 requesting that the Summit County Fiscal Officer make an advanced payment of tax funds for tax year 2019 payable in 2020 to the City of Akron Treasury Division; and declaring an emergency. Vote 12-0 (Neal absent)

- 3 ORD 275-2019 amending Ordinance No. 93-2019, passed March 25, 2019, which established the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2019; and declaring an emergency. Vote 12-0 (Neal absent)

- 4 ORD 276-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement/participatory legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for certain improvements of the Princeton Street Bridge over State Route 76; declaring that said project is in the public interest; and declaring an emergency. Vote 12-0 (Neal absent)

- 5 RES 277-2019 declaring it necessary to improve East Market Street between the termini of Canton Road and Interstate 76, Seiberling Street between the termini of Triplett Boulevard and Archwood Avenue, Innovation Way between the termini of East Market Street and Seiberling Street, Vernon Odom Boulevard between the termini of Romig Road and McTaggart Drive and Opportunity Parkway between the termini of Edgewood Avenue and Cedar Street by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency. Vote 12-0 (Neal absent)

- 6 ORD 278-2019 denying application by Eco-Site, LLC and T-Mobile for Conditional Use approval of proposed 75 ft. telecommunications tower at 550 E. Wilbeth Road in the City of Akron (PC-2016-89-CU); adopting associated findings; and declaring an emergency. SUBSTITUTE OFFERED AS AN AMENDMENT. Vote 12-0 (Neal absent)

- 7 ORD 279-2019 denying application by Eco-Site, LLC and T-Mobile for Conditional Use approval of proposed 100 ft. telecommunications tower at 1554 South Hawkins Avenue in the City of Akron (PC-2017-44-CU); adopting associated findings; and declaring an emergency. SUBSTITUTE OFFERED AS AN AMENDMENT. Vote 10-0 (Sommerville, Keith abstained) (Neal absent)

- 8 ORD 280-2019 approving the expenditure of additional funds for mowing of publicly-owned and privately-owned lots, beyond the amounts authorized in Ordinance No. 17-2019; and declaring an emergency. Vote 11-0 (Neal, Swirsky absent)
