AKRON CITY COUNCIL ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 7, 2019

- 1 ORD 281-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into an oil and/or gas lease agreement with Discovery Oil and Gas, LLC for the mineral rights of 2.90 acres of City-owned land for completion of the “Kopsky Unit No. 1D” gas/oil well drilling unitization; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 2 ORD 282-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into an oil and/or gas lease agreement with Discovery Oil and Gas, LLC for the mineral rights of 2.87 acres of City-owned land for completion of the “Kintz Unit No. 1” gas/oil well drilling unitization; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 3 ORD 283-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into an oil and/or gas lease agreement with Discovery Oil and Gas, LLC for the mineral rights of 4.26 acres of City-owned land for completion of the “Eubanks Unit No. 1D” gas/oil well drilling unitization; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 4 ORD 284-2019 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$2,020,000, for the purpose acquiring an easement over property located at 47 North Main Street in the City and in furtherance of economic development purposes of the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 5 ORD 285-2019 accepting a vacation plat for Modena Drive, north to its terminus; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 6 ORD 286-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Path Master, Inc., for the purchase of a two-year software maintenance agreement for the Centracs traffic-signal monitoring program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 7 ORD 287-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a commercial storage facility on Springfield Lake Boulevard, east of George Washington Boulevard; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 8 ORD 288-2019 amending The Zoning Map by changing the Single Family Residential Use District Classification (U1, H1, A1) Use on property located at 715 E. Buchtel Avenue, to a Retail Business Use District Classification (U3, H4, A5) Use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 9 RES 289-2019 establishing October 20-26, 2019, as Lead Poisoning Prevention Week and encouraging Akron parents and grandparents who care for children under the age of six to ensure a lead safe environment and participate in the Lead Prevention programs the City of Akron provides; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 10 ORD 290-2019 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to accept and expend funding from The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company Better Future Grant; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
