AKRON CITY COUNCIL ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 21, 2019

- 1 ORD 291-2019 approving the sale of vacant City-owned property at 1319 Markle St. to Summit Towing, LLC AKA Mastertech Auto Truck Repair & Sales pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and to reduce the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 2 ORD 292-2019 approving the donation of 1881 17th St., SW and 825 Silvercrest Ave. to Nazareth Housing Development Corporation; determining said properties are not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 3 ORD 293-2019 approving the sale of various City-owned properties pursuant to the City's "A Lot for a Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and to reduce the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 4 ORD 294-2019 authorizing the transfer of City-owned property on Hartford, Sumner, and Allyn Streets to Akron Public Schools in exchange for property owned by said Akron Public Schools on Peckham Street; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 5 ORD 295-2019 approving the sale of vacant City-owned property in the Akron Land Banking Project; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 6 ORD 296-2019 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into a contract or contracts, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Siemens Industry Inc. for the integration of a door security system at the Municipal Service Center; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 7 ORD 297-2019 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into contract or contracts for the purchase and installation of windows at Lock 3; and declaring an emergency.

- 8 ORD 298-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a child daycare business center at 1868 Marigold Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

- 9 ORD 299-2019 approving and authorizing the sale of City-owned land comprised of 20 vacant parcels located on N. Walnut Street, Aetna Street, N. Maple Street, King Court, Division Street, Smith Street, and West Street, to 183 West Market Street Holdings, LLC; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 10 ORD 300-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a two-unit dwelling at 418 Crestwood Avenue; and declaring an emergency.
