### RULES

- 1 RESOLUTION supporting the State of Ohio in establishing the honorary designation of a section of State Route 261, between North Main Street and Home Avenue, as “Marine Cpl. Andrew D. Brownfield Memorial Highway;” and declaring an emergency.

### BUDGET & FINANCE

- 2 ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$41,300,000, for the purpose of retiring a portion of notes issued to pay costs of various improvements in the City; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$5,450,000, to pay the costs of improving municipal buildings and facilities in the City; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$1,800,000, to pay the costs of acquiring and equipping motor vehicles for certain Divisions in the City; and declaring an emergency.
- 5 ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$935,000, to pay the costs of improving the municipal parks and recreational system in the City; and declaring an emergency.

6 ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$6,155,000, to pay the costs of constructing, reconstructing, and otherwise improving certain streets in the City; and declaring an emergency.

7 ORDINANCE providing for the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$1,545,611.24 of bonds, to pay, in anticipation of the collection of special assessments heretofore levied, the property owners' portion of the cost of improving certain streets in the City; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC SERVICE**

8 ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Perram Electric to replace the existing regulator for the T-hangar, and troubleshoot and repair multiple underground and transformer issues on the existing taxiway at the Akron Fulton Airport; and declaring an emergency.

9 ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with the Bell Equipment Company to provide for factory refurbishment of three Epoke spreaders for use by Highway Maintenance; and declaring an emergency.

10 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Liberta Construction for the emergency repair of the sanitary sewer lateral at 705 S. Arlington Street; and declaring an emergency.

11 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Cocklin Plumbing and Trenching, Inc., for the emergency repair of the storm sewer under the Wheeling & Lake Erie railroad at Pondview Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC UTILITIES**

12 ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with The Macomb Group for the purchase of 10 filter-effluent-valve actuators to replace those that have worn-out at the City's Water Supply Plant; and declaring an emergency.

13 ORDINANCE approving the expenditure of additional funds for the purchase of additional potassium permanganate from Bonded Chemicals for continued treatment of drinking water at the Akron Water Plant, beyond the amounts authorized in Ordinance No. 17-2019; and declaring an emergency.

## **HEALTH & SOCIAL SERVICE**

RESOLUTION approving and confirming the re-appointments of Tom Nikola, Ken Harmon, Francis Ladd, and Brenna Herman to the Senior Citizens Commission; and declaring an emergency.
