### AKRON CITY COUNCIL ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 28, 2019

- 1 RES 301-2019 declaring it necessary to improve Waterloo Road between the termini of Glenmount Avenue and Kelly Avenue by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)
- 2 RES 302-2019 declaring it necessary to improve Waterloo Road between the termini of Manchester Road and Glenmount Avenue by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)
- 3 ORD 303-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into a contract or contracts with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the Safe Routes to School 2019 Program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)
- 4 ORD 304-2019 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into Water Pollution Control Loan Fund ("WPCLF") agreements with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA") and/or the Ohio Water Development Authority ("OWDA") for the construction of the Sanitary Sewer Reconstruction 2018 Large Diameter Lining Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)
- 5 ORD 305-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for construction of the Sanitary Sewer Reconstruction 2018 Large Diameter Lining Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)
- 6 ORD 306-2019 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into Water Pollution Control Loan Fund ("WPCLF") agreements with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA") and the Ohio Water Development Authority ("OWDA") for the construction of the Cuyahoga Street Storage Facility Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)
- 7 ORD 307-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the improvement, repair, and/or rehabilitation of the

- Cuyahoga Street Storage Facility and associated areas (CSO Rack 40); and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)
- 8 RES 308-2019 approving and confirming the reappointment of Donald Christian, Mark Derrig, and Renee Greene to the Metropolitan Regional Transit Authority (“Metro”) Board of Trustees; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)
- 9 ORD 309-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts to provide water service connections and eliminate certain existing public water systems (“PWS”) as part of the Akron PWS Regionalization Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)
- 10 ORD 310-2019 authorizing the Mayor to negotiate execute and deliver a Cooperative and Disbursing Agreement related to the redevelopment of property located at 47 N. Main Street in connection with The Smithers Group, Inc. World Headquarters Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 11 ORD 311-2019 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Taylor-Made Ambulance to provide for the remounting and refurbishment of one 2007 Taylor-Made Emergency Medical Unit; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 12 RES 312-2019 supporting the State of Ohio in establishing the honorary designation of a section of State Route 261, between North Main Street and Home Avenue, as “Marine Cpl. Andrew D. Brownfield Memorial Highway;” and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 13 RES 313-2019 acknowledging the accomplishments and public service career of Congressman Elijah E. Cummings; expressing condolences and sympathy to the family of Congressman Cummings on his passing; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 14 ORD 314-2019 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$41,300,000, for the purpose of retiring a portion of notes issued to pay costs of various improvements in the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 15 ORD 315-2019 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$5,450,000, to pay the costs of improving municipal buildings and facilities in the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 16 ORD 316-2019 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$1,800,000, to pay the costs of acquiring and equipping motor vehicles for certain Divisions in the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 17 ORD 317-2019 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$935,000, to pay the costs of improving the municipal parks and recreational system in the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 18 ORD 318-2019 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$6,155,000, to pay the costs of constructing, reconstructing, and otherwise improving certain streets in the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 19 ORD 319-2019 providing for the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$1,545,611.24 of bonds, to pay, in anticipation of the collection of special assessments heretofore levied, the property owners' portion of the cost of improving certain streets in the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 20 RES 320-2019 approving and confirming the re-appointments of Tom Nikola, Ken Harmon, Francis Ladd, and Brenna Herman to the Senior Citizens Commission; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
