### AKRON CITY COUNCIL ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED NOVEMBER 25, 2019

- 1      ORD 332-2019 authorizing the sale of certain City-owned properties pursuant to the City's "A Lot for a Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the properties and to reduce the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
  
- 2      ORD 333-2019 authorizing the purchase of 55 Glendale Ave. for the Land Banking Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Ombobien absent)
  
- 3      ORD 334-2019 authorizing the purchase of various interests in real property located on or around Canto Road to facilitate the completion of Sum 91 – Canton Rd/Market St. Project; authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee to enter into related agreements; authorizing payment for same; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
  
- 4      ORD 335-2019 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to execute a relocation grant agreement with Promerus, LLC to support job creation in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
  
- 5      ORD 336-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a parking lot on the west side of Yellowstone Avenue (PN 6802592), south of E. Tallmadge Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
  
- 6      ORD 337-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a warehouse and offices at 1011 Gorge Boulevard; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
  
- 7      ORD 338-2019 providing for the temporary appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the period of January 1, 2020 through March 31, 2020; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Omobien absent)
