AKRON CITY COUNCIL ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED DECEMBER 2, 2019

- 1 ORD 339-2019 authorizing the Director of Finance to enter into an agreement with The University of Akron School of Law to provide an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for its expungement program in 2020; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman did not vote) (Kammer absent)

- 2 ORD 340-2019 approving the sale of certain City-owned property located at 103, 109, 117, 121 and 123 North Adolph Street to Summa Health System pursuant to the Summa Urban Renewal Area Project; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman did not vote) (Kammer absent)

- 3 ORD 341-2019 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in his actions of entering into a contract with HM Miller Construction for the emergency repair of the invert of the culvert below Sand Run Road at Sand Run Parkway; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman did not vote) (Kammer absent)

- 4 ORD 342-2019 determining to proceed with the improvement of East Market Street between the termini of Canton Road and Interstate 76, Seiberling Street between the termini of Triplett Boulevard and Archwood Avenue, Innovation Way between the termini of East Market Street and Seiberling Street, Vernon Odom Boulevard between the termini of Romig Road and McTaggart Drive and Opportunity Parkway between the termini of Edgewood Avenue and Cedar Street by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman did not vote) (Kammer absent)

- 5 ORD 343-2019 approving the expenditure of additional funds for the purchase of additional Powder Activated Carbon (PAC) for continued treatment of drinking water at the Akron Water Plant, beyond the amounts authorized in Ordinance No. 17-2019; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman did not vote) (Kammer absent)

- 6 ORD 344-2019 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the relocation of a water main for the improvement of State Route 18; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman did not vote) (Kammer absent)
- 7 ORD 345-2019 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Interval Brotherhood Home to provide comprehensive residential drug and alcohol treatment to eligible individuals; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman did not vote) (Kammer absent)
- 8 ORD 346-2019 amending and/or supplementing Title 9, Chapter 94 “Health, Safety and Sanitation,” Section 94.99 “Penalty” by adding administrative fines as a penalty for violation of Section 94.19.2; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman did not vote) (Kammer absent)
- 9 RES 347-2019 setting forth the timing and process for the organizational meeting of the incoming new Council; providing for other matters related to the new Council; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer absent)
- 10 ORD 348-2019 declaring certain improvements to real property located in the Home Avenue Redevelopment Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation; providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes and the deposit of those service payments in the appropriate fund; providing for the payment of a portion of the service payments to the Akron Public School District, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the “Act”); and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer absent)
- 11 ORD 349-2019 authorizing the purchase of 1762 Merriman Road for the Merriman Valley Train Depot Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer absent)
- 12 ORD 350-2019 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to participate in the Water Resource Restoration Sponsor Program (WRRSP) and to enter into a Sponsorship Agreement with the entities listed in Exhibit A for the sponsorship of environmental restoration and preservation projects under the WRRSP; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer absent)
