RULES

- 1 Resolution expressing support of CROWN (Creating a Respectful and Open Workplace for Natural Hair) legislation (“CROWN Legislation”); calling upon the Ohio General Assembly to introduce and pass legislation creating state-wide CROWN Legislation; and declaring an emergency.

PLANNING & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- 2 Ordinance authorizing a conditional use to establish a production kitchen and market at 462 Harvey Avenue; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing scheduled for 3/9/20)
- 3 Ordinance authorizing a conditional use to construct an addition onto a commercial building at 80 Cole Avenue; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing scheduled for 3/9/20)
- 4 Resolution approving and confirming the appointment by the Mayor of Gary Wyatt and Stephanie York as members of the City Planning Commission, and Bronlynn Thurman as an alternate member; and declaring an emergency.
- 5 Ordinance approving the sale of City owned properties to Hamilton DeSaussure, Jr. and Mary DeSaussure, and Douglas D. Fleming; determining said properties are not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
- 6 Ordinance authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into contracts for transportation planning services in order to carry out the intent and purpose of programs under the Federal Consolidated Planning Grant for the fiscal year 2020, and in order to further the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study's goals and objectives of maintaining a cooperative, continuous, and comprehensive framework for making transportation investment decisions in the Akron metropolitan area; and declaring an emergency.
- 7 Ordinance authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into an agreement with Bounce Innovation Hub ("Bounce") in order to further the continuing and future success of Bounce, and to obtain certain exclusive benefits for the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.
- 8 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with The Apostolos Group, Inc., d.b.a. Thomarios for emergency services and materials associated with the vacation of the building at 146 S. High Street, including relocation of City personnel to other City-owned facilities; and declaring an emergency.
- 9 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and grant an easement on City-owned property to Akron Children's Hospital to install and/or repair/replace conduit duct banks under Water Street; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE

- 10 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into contract or contracts for the construction of Citywide Sidewalks 2020; and declaring an emergency.

- 11 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the replacement of the hot water boiler at Balch Street Community Center; and declaring an emergency.
