## ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED AT PREVIOUS MEETING

- 1      ORD 23-2020 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, or her designee, to enter into a contract or contracts for the renewal of Business Automobile Liability Insurance, Primary and Excess Liability coverage for all City of Akron Vehicles and physical damage insurance coverage including Fire Division vehicles and EMS Units for a period of March 20, 2020, to March 20, 2023; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
  
- 2      ORD 24-2020 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, or her designee, to enter into a contract or contracts for the renewal of Property Insurance for Large Mobile Equipment costing over \$50,000 for a period of March 1, 2020, to March 1, 2023; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
  
- 3      ORD 25-2020 ratifying the actions of the Mayor in entering into a lease agreement with Alan E. Ederer for retail space in the city-owned Broadway Parking Deck; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 4 ORD 26-2020 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into an agreement and grant an easement on City-owned property at 226 Opportunity Parkway to the East Ohio Gas Company dba Dominion Energy Ohio; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 5 ORD 27-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the removal and replacement of the concrete Taxiway H1 at Akron Executive Airport; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 6 ORD 28-2020 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract or contracts, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Gray Matter Systems for the purchase of a GE iFix Global Care Complete Software support package for the Water Supply Bureau; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 7 ORD 29-2020 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Cardinal Environmental Services, Inc. for the emergency soil and groundwater cleanup at Darrow Road in Hudson; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 8 ORD 30-2020 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a child day care business center at 1204 Coral Drive; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 9 ORD 31-2020 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a child day care business center at 1170 Diagonal Road; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 10 RES 32-2020 adopting the 2020 Capital Investment and Community Development Program, legally referred to as the Capital Investment Budget; and declaring an emergency. Substitue Offered as an Amendment. VOTE 13-0
- 11 ORD 33-2020 amending and/or supplementing Title 3, Chapter 38 "Unlawful Discrimination," of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 12 RES 34-2020 approving and confirming the appointment by Mayor Horrigan of Esther Thomas, LaTonda Belcher, and Nancy Holland as members of the Akron Civil Rights Commission; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
  
- 13 ORD 35-2020 approving the agreement between the Akron Firefighters Association, Local #330 bargaining unit and the City of Akron regarding adjustments in employee compensation, all in furtherance of the Mayor's commitment to attract and retain qualified employees and provide appropriate wage increases commensurate with improved employee productivity and efficiency, and changes in the cost of living, while economically utilizing taxpayer dollars to provide vital, quality services to the citizens of the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
  
- 14 ORD 36-2020 amending and/or supplementing Ordinance No. 17-2016, approving the agreements between the Akron Firefighters Association, Local #330 bargaining unit and the City of Akron regarding changes in health care benefits; authorizing the Director of Finance to fund these benefits; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
  
- 15 RES 37-2020 declaring it necessary to improve Ascot Parkway between the termini of State Road and the cul-de-sac by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs and driveway approaches; and installing roof drain pipes; repealing Resolution No. 11-2020; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
  
- 16 RES 38-2020 declaring it necessary to improve 4th Street between the termini of Maryland Avenue and Kenmore Boulevard by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
