ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED AT PREVIOUS MEETING

- 1 ORD 39-2020 accepting a vacation plat for Ewing Court, west of Adolph Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (*Malik Abstained*)
- 2 ORD 40-2020 accepting a vacation plat for Arch Street and a portion of Upson Street, west of N. Adams Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (*Malik Abstained*)
- 3 ORD 41-2020 declaring certain improvements to real property located in the Downtown Area Redevelopment Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation; providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes and the deposit of those service payments in the appropriate fund; providing for the payment of a portion of the service payments to the Akron Public School District, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the "Act"); and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (*Malik Abstained*)

- 4 ORD 42-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee to enter into an agreement with the Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority (“AMHA”) in order to perform and/or manage certain environmental reviews; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (*Malik Abstained*)
- 5 ORD 43-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Service, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for planting of trees in connection with the Akron Waterways Renewed Program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (*Malik Abstained*)
- 6 ORD 44-2020 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Grayshift for the use of the GrayKey Online software bundle for up to three years; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (*Malik Abstained*)
- 7 RES 45-2020 expressing support of CROWN (Creating a Respectful and Open Workplace for Natural Hair) legislation (“CROWN Legislation”); calling upon the Ohio General Assembly to introduce and pass legislation creating state-wide CROWN Legislation; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 8 RES 46-2020 approving and confirming the appointment by the Mayor of Gary Wyatt and Stephanie York as members of the City Planning Commission, and Bronlynn Thurman as an alternate member; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
