ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED AT SPECIAL MEETING – March 20, 2020

ORD 70-2020 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into a contract or contracts with the Board of Education of the Akron Public School District for the Community Learning Centers' Akron After School Program in order to provide learning enrichment activities; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 9-0 (Neal Abstained) (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

RES 71-2020 declaring it necessary to improve South Hawkins Avenue between the termini of Iona Avenue and Mull Avenue by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 9-0 (Neal Abstained) (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 72-2020 repealing Chapter 92 "Animals," Section 92.30, "Public Exhibition of Animals"; amending Section 92.99, "Penalty"; Repealing Chapter 111, "Regulations Governing Specific Businesses," Article 37, "Petting Zoos," Sections 111.620 to 111.625, inclusive, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 9-0 (Neal Abstained) (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

RES 73-2020 expressing appreciation to Dr. John Green for his career of

ORD 74-2020 accepting various interests in real property for certain properties described below to facilitate the completion of the Sum 91 – Canton Rd./Market St. Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 9-0 (Neal Abstained) (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 75-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the construction of the foundation and landscaping for the Main Street bronze rubber-worker statue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 9-0 (Neal Abstained) (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 76-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Service to submit an application and enter into an agreement with the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority for a Community Recycling Access Grant, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan’s objectives of supporting new and existing community recycling projects; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 9-0 (Neal Abstained) (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 77-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2020 Resurfacing Program – Residential Resurfacing, including alternates; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 9-0 (Neal Abstained) (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 78-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2020 Resurfacing Program – Arterial & Collector Streets Resurfacing, including alternates; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 9-0 (Neal Abstained) (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 79-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2020 Resurfacing Program – Unimproved Street Resurfacing, including alternates; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 9-0 (Neal Abstained) (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 80-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Service, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the demolition and removal of the trailer park located at Eckert Ditch, including the trailers, houses, barn, and associated appurtenances; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 9-0 (Neal Abstained) (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 81-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Service, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Watson-Marlow for the purchase of four chemical transfer pumps for the Akron Water Plant; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 9-0 (Neal Abstained) (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

RES 82-2020 adopting an annual operating budget for the fiscal year 2020; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 9-0 (Neal Abstained) (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 83-2020 to make the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 9-0 (Neal Abstained) (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 84-2020 establishing a Charter Review Commission and approving and confirming appointments by the Mayor of the membership of the Commission; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 85-2020 accepting various interests in real property for a certain property described below to facilitate the completion of Sum 91 – Canton Rd./Market St. Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 86-2020 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into a contract with Oriana House, Inc. for confinement, rehabilitation services and alternative sentencing options for certain offenders convicted of violations of the Akron Municipal Code; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

RES 87-2020 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2020 Phase I Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

RES 88-2020 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2020 Phase I Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

RES 89-2020 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2020 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface, and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 90-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Service, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Great Lakes Construction Co. and Kenmore Construction Co., Inc., for the emergency repair of the sanitary sewers under Springfield Lake Outlet, East Avenue, and South Main Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 91-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract and make payment to the City of Fairlawn for concrete and asphalt pavement restoration completed by the City of Fairlawn; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 92-2020 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with H.M. Miller Construction Co., Inc. for the emergency repair of a water main on Firestone Parkway; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

ORD 93-2020 amending sick leave and paid leave ordinances to provide for temporary adjustments to allow for flexible leave usage during the state of emergency declared due to the COVID-19 (coronavirus) crisis. VOTE 10-0 (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

RES 94-2020 urging the Ohio General Assembly to take immediate action to affirm that—during a declared state of emergency in which public gatherings are restricted to maintain public health or safety—live streaming public meetings and permitting public bodies to attend meetings and conduct business by means of teleconference or video conference satisfies the requirements of the Open Meetings Act; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)

RES 95-2020 declaring that the Council of the City of Akron shall be in recess until further action of Council; suspending all regularly scheduled meetings; suspending certain Rules of Procedure to enable the Council to continue to conduct business during this time of national, state, and local emergency, in accordance with applicable law; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Baylor, Connor, Samples absent)
