ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED

Special Meeting - May 4, 2020

ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED AT PREVIOUS MEETING

- 1 ORD 119-2020 authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development, or his designee, to donate two parcels of land to the Urban Neighborhood Development Corporation; determining said property is not needed for a public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0 (Baylor did not vote)**

- 2 ORD 120-2020 authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development, or his designee, to sell the City-owned property located at 550 Cuyahoga Street; determining said property is not needed for a public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

- 3 ORD 121-2020 authorizing the Mayor, Director of Planning and Urban Development, the Purchasing Agent and the Director of Public Service of the City of Akron authorized on behalf of the City of Akron to sell City-owned land to the West Creek Conservancy; determining said property is not needed for a public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

- 4 ORD 122-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for construction of the Akron Fulton Airport Runway 7-25 rehabilitation; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

- 5 ORD 123-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into an agreement or agreements to grant a standard highway easement to the Ohio Department of Transportation for the widening of State Route 608 and a temporary easement for construction

of the same; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

6 ORD 124-2020 authorizing the purchasing agent, having already publicly advertised for bids, to enter into an agreement or agreements with Pro-Tech Security Sales for the purchase of gas masks and annunciators; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

7 ORD 125-2020 authorizing the Mayor to apply for, and if awarded, accept a Violence Against Women Act grant administered by the Office of Criminal Justice Services; authorizing the Director of Law to enter into an agreement with Oriana House, Inc. to implement the grant by continuing to fund two investigators for the domestic violence unit; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**
