

Summary of Resolution No. 263-2021 enacted by Akron City Council November 1, 2021 declaring it necessary to improve Copley Road between the termini of Mercer Avenue and Trigonía Drive; South Maple Street between the termini of Trigonía Drive and Glendale Avenue; Manchester Road between the termini of East Avenue and Wilbeth Road; and East Avenue between the termini of Vernon Odom Boulevard and Manchester Road by resurfacing, all together with the necessary appurtenances. The resolution approves the plans, specifications, profiles and cost estimate for the improvement; determines to assess a portion of the cost of the improvement against property benefitted by the improvement; authorizes the preparation, filing and notification to property owners of the special assessment for the improvement; provides for the appointment of an assessment equalization board if objections are filed; and provides for the method for payment of the special assessment. The resolution was enacted as an emergency measure and went into effect upon its adoption.
