TRAFFIC CONTROL REGULATION**

#13-2024

Under the authority granted by Title 7, Code of Ordinances of Akron, Ohio, 1993, the following traffic control regulations are hereby made:

No Parking Any Time – Classification 25

Homewood Avenue, east side, from Cramer Avenue to East Market Street.

McCoy Street, south side, from Wolf Ledges Parkway to Grant Street.

Repeal**No Parking Any Time – Classification 25**

Arlington Street, west side, from Buchtel Avenue to Hazel Street. (Ord. 411-1953)

Arlington Street, North, west side, from the north property line of Kent Street to a point 233 feet north thereof. (Order #58-1971)

Homewood Avenue, east side, from the south property line of Englewood Avenue to a point 120 feet south thereof. (Order #3-1991)

Johnland Avenue, north side, from the west property line of Eastland Avenue to a point 32 feet west thereof. (Order #20-1972)

Market Street, north side, from the east property line of Broadway Street to a point 75 feet east thereof. (Order #21-1966)

McCoy Street, north side, from Grant Street to Wolf Ledges. (Order #29-1980)

McCoy Street, south side, from Washington Street to Grant Street. (Ord. 525-1947)

Roselle Avenue, north side, from the west property line of Manchester Road to a point 50 feet west thereof. (Order #15-1961)

Roselle Avenue, south side, from the west property line of Manchester Road to a point 150 feet west thereof. (Order #15-1961)

Stone Street, east side, from the north property line of Upson Street to a point 51 feet north thereof. (Order #8-1990)

Sweitzer Avenue, west side, from Archwood Avenue to Mapledale Avenue. (Order #10-1986)


Through Vehicles Over 5 Tons Prohibited – Section 72-1
