

Summary of Resolution No. 153-2025 passed by Akron City Council May 5, 2025, declaring it necessary to improve Shelburn between the termini of Canton Road and 30' west of Kreiner Avenue, Berne Street between the termini of Canton Road and Shelburn Avenue, High Grove Boulevard between the termini of Albrecht Avenue and 50' south of Davenport Avenue, Baker Avenue between 42' east of Massillon Road and 36' west of Hilbish Avenue, Income Drive between 110' east of Darrow Road and 150' east of Dorset Street and Springfield Center Road between 45' east of Massillon Road and 73' west of Hilbish Avenue by the repair of concrete pavement; being the restoration of concrete pavement to its original grade and surface condition by replacement of defective sections, grinding or other means, all together with the necessary appurtenances. The resolution repeals Resolution No. 126-2025 and approves the plans, specifications, profiles and cost estimate for the improvement, determines to assess a portion of the cost of the improvement against property benefited by the improvement; authorizes the preparation, filing and notification to property owners of the special assessment for the improvement; provides for the appointment of an assessment equalization board if objections are filed; and provides for the method for payment of the special assessments. The resolution was enacted as an emergency measure and went into effect upon its adoption.
