

Summary of Resolution No. 53-2026 passed by Akron City Council February 23, 2026, declaring it necessary to improve Wendling Drive from Pelee Drive to East End, Pelee Drive 60 feet north of Wendling Drive and Arborway Drive 60 feet north of Wendling Drive by paving, grading, constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, storm sewers and sanitary sewers, installing roof drain pipes and planting trees, all together with the necessary appurtenances. The resolution approves the plans, specifications, profiles and cost estimate for the improvement; determines to assess a portion of the cost of the improvement against property benefited by the improvement; authorizes the preparation, filing and notification to property owners of the special assessment for the improvement; provides for the appointment of an assessment equalization board if objections are filed; and provides for the method for payment of the special assessments. The resolution was enacted as an emergency measure and went into effect upon its adoption.
