1. Ordinance authorizing a Conditional Use to replace a static billboard with a digital billboard at 236 Annadale Avenue.
2. Ordinance amending/supplementing Title 15, Chapter 153, "Zoning Code", Article 6 "Development and Area District Requirements", Section 153.310 "Business and industry requirements" by changing signage requirements within the Kenmore Urban Overlay Area.
3. Ordinance authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an addition at 134 Western Avenue.
